ENGAGEMENT WITH THE DEVOLVED ADMINISTRATIONS, GIBRALTAR, OVERSEAS TERRITORIES AND CROWN DEPENDENCIES

Thank you for your letter, dated 13 November 2018, regarding the Government's technical notice on *Funding for British Overseas Territories if there's no Brexit deal*. The House of Lords European Union Select Committee considered this document at its meeting on 11 December 2018.

Nevertheless, we are disappointed at the lack of clarity in response to some of our questions, notably the lack of any considered response to the specific concerns regarding EIB funding raised with us by the British Virgin Islands and Gibraltar. We also note your statement that "I am not in a position at present to elaborate on our ongoing discussions with the Commission ... but I can assure you that we will raise all points relevant to the Overseas Territories at the appropriate time." Given that the negotiations on the Withdrawal Agreement and Political declaration have now concluded, are you now able to elaborate on these discussions? If not, can you clarify when will be "the appropriate time" to raise these issues with the Commission?

We would be grateful for a more detailed response to these points, as well as an account of the December UK OT Joint Ministerial Council, by 10 January 2019.
